## TA 101 Introductory Course - 4 hours each on 20 April, 11 May, 1 June

- celebrating 30 years of the Internet, thanks to Tim Berners-Lee, who has given us the ability to work with TA in a truly world-wide fashion;
- using Zoom which enables us to see each other, talk to each other, and chat in smaller groups in breakout rooms;
- led by a trainer who is qualified in all fields of TA application, has travelled and taught TA in over 40 countries and had many professional contacts in yet more countries.

### The program will:

- be run to the internationally agreed syllabus that incorporates coverage of the wide range of interlinking concepts that are nowadays contained under the overall heading of 'transactional analysis proper';
- include well-known but often misinterpreted concepts such as Parent – Adult – Child, different strokes for different folks, games people play, life scripts, I'm OK You're OK.....;
- and less well known but amazingly useful ideas such as why we don't know what we don't know, child development and how this impacts our grown-up reactions to change, the autonomy matrix, the steps to success ..... and lots more!
